As a school, we are exceptionally proud of our partnership working. By sharing this information, we will continue to work closely with parents in order that all children have the best possible start at Christ the King and achieve 'life to the full'.

In 2022, a number of papers went missing nationally. This affected all children at Christ the King for Maths Paper 3. School leaders have worked closely with the Local Authority to do all they can to address this with the relevant bodies but remain without marks for Paper 3. We recognise this is disappointing for children and families and share that disappointment. This has further impacted the range of data that can accurately be relied upon. This has been indicated by N/A.

Below is a table showing the results from 2018 – 2019 for Christ the King. In addition we have published the headline data for 2021 – 2022 which is the first year of national testing following the global pandemic. We have shown this alongside the data for our Local Authority and National data.
