What to expect

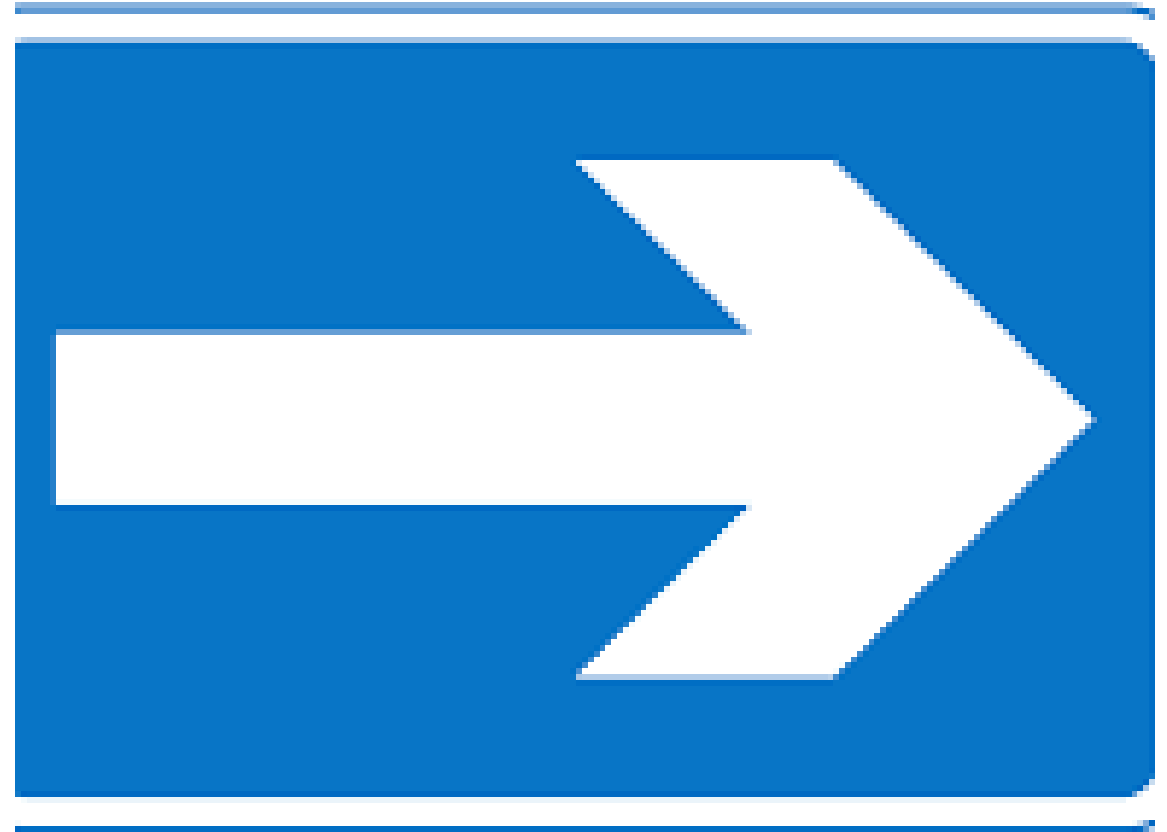
Adults may wear a mask or face covering in class or at the gate and gloves or an apron if they

Safely Dropping off Your Child

- There is a **one-way route**.
- Please come to the **bottom of the school path** (Robin Hood Road, next to field) @ socially distant, paint marked intervals
- A member of staff will be there to greet you.
- Please **say goodbye** to the children at the **top pedestrian gate**.
- Classes will be met by their teachers for the day and led to the external door access to classrooms
- Parents will leave by following one-way system down the public footpath or Fir Grove.

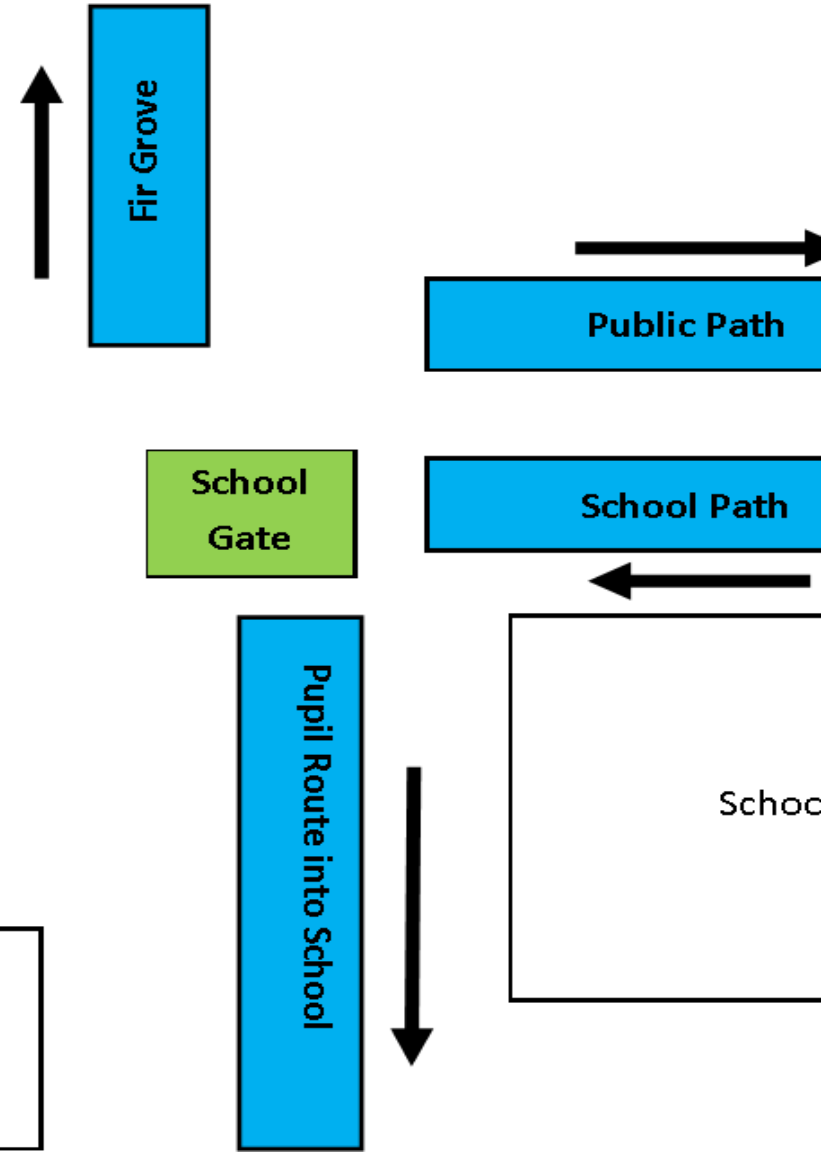


SCHOOL ROUTE

Blue Box shows one way routes. Please follow the **one way system** and **2m social distancing** expectations.

Green Box shows drop off and pick up point. Please drop and pick off at this point following the **designated one way route** and the **2m social distancing** expectations.

Lunch time

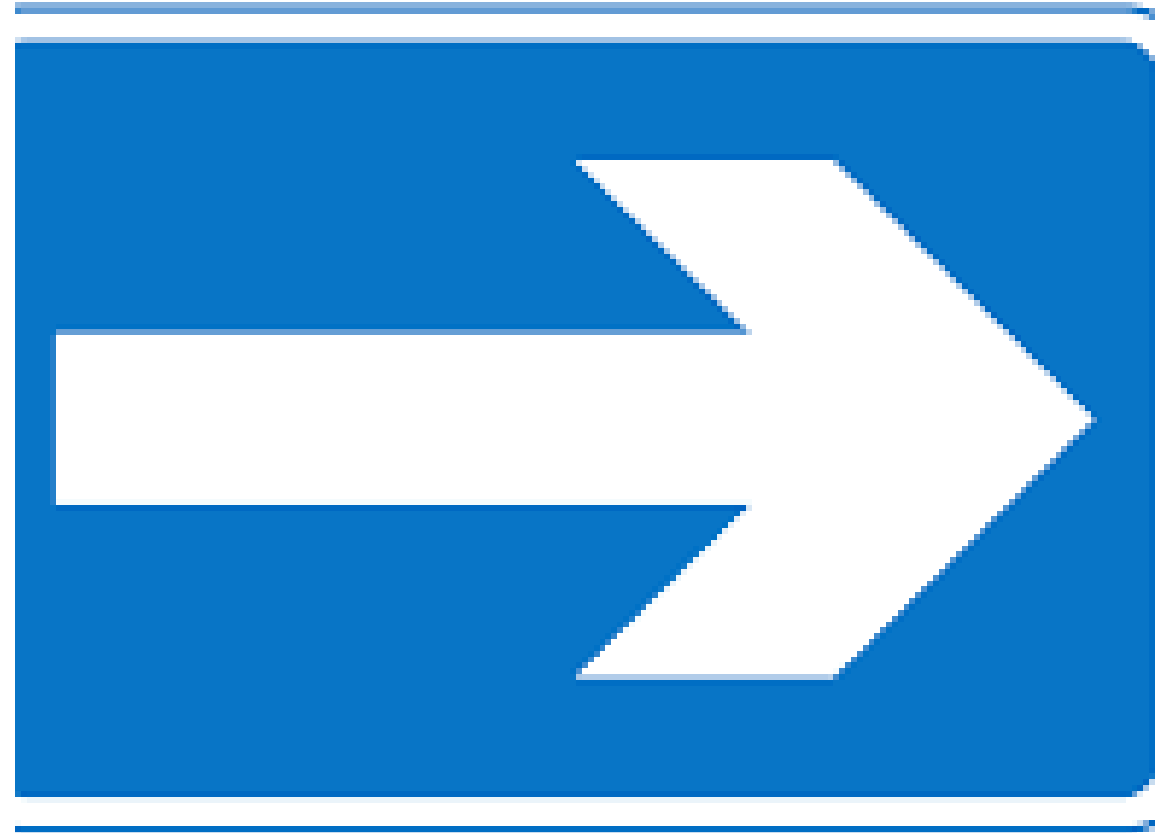
These continue to be at staggered times in order to
