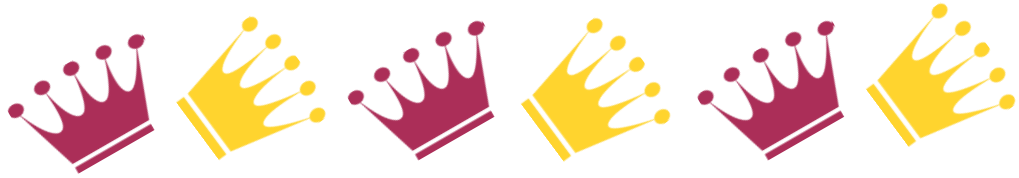

It is important that parents contact school every day that a child is absent from school.

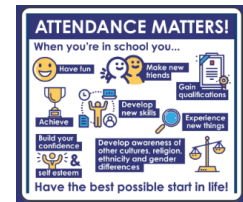
