October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month.

We all know domestic violence is common, but lots of people don't realise just how common it is. An estimated 1.4 million women and 751,000 men experienced domestic abuse last year in England and Wales. It's something one in five of us will experience, but only a quarter of these crimes are reported.

So, what can we do? Firstly, share information. Did you know that if you need to call 999, but can't speak, you can make a silent 999 call? After you've dialled tap in 55 on your mobile, it will connect you to the police, who should then be able to find you.
