With Christmas nearly here and with some children receiving new technology or related games, here is a quick reminder of the importance of setting up appropriate parental controls.

- * Games/Consoles - Check age ratings: look at the PEGI rating of any new games. - Remember, PEGI rates the gameplay so whilst it is important to review age ratings, you must also check to see if it has any communication elements.
- * If a game does allow your child to communicate with others, then adjust or disable the settings as appropriate to your child.
- * On the device itself, set up applicable controls such as restricting spending limits and managing who they can communicate with.
