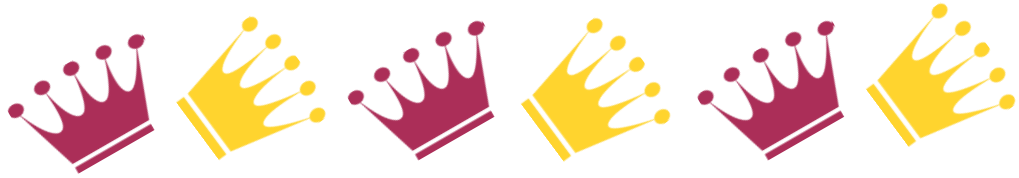

Anti-Bullying Week 2025: Power for Good

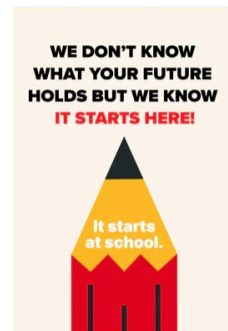
In our daily lives, we share spaces with many People - family, friends, classmates, colleagues, and strangers. Each person has a story, dreams, and feelings, just like you.
