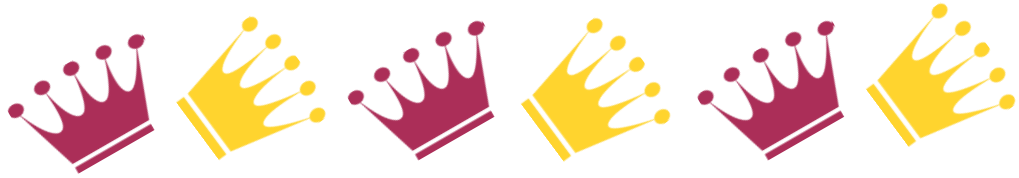

⇒ **Pavement parking is a no-go too!**
